JUDGES COMMENTARY AND SCORE SHEETS will be presented to each band at the retreat ceremony. All judges commentary will be on a flash drive and not downloaded to the web page for immediate access.

SCORES: will not be posted. They will be announced at the Retreat ceremony. All Bands must have representation at Retreat. Saturday night retreat will include only DMs and COs.

WRISTBANDS: The members' wristbands are enclosed in the packet you will receive when you check in at your site. Please see that every band member gets one, this is their only way back into the stadium to watch other performing units. The one plastic wrist band is to be used for both days and are water proof. The numbers of wrist bands is determined by the numbers you filled out on the application at the beginning of the season. If your numbers have changed please advise the WBA office ASAP. If you have defective wrist bands bring them to the WBA check in representative and they will be replaced.

PIT PASSES: Pit passes are also enclosed in the packet, and will serve you for both days.

PATCHES: All patches will be distributed at the Retreat ceremony on Saturday.

PIT EQUIPMENT: Pit carts will use the performer entrance into both facilities. Prior to entering the performance area, (the goal line) wait for the timing and penalty judge to give you the go ahead to proceed. After unloading the equipment, move pit carts to the end of field, opposite the stadium pit cart entrance, make a U-turn and wait for the completion of the performing band. Stay off of the performance field. **NO CARTS MAY BE ON THE TURF. YOU MUST STAY ON THE TRACK**

BUS DRIVERS: Will be allowed free access to the show. They must be in uniform or have an I.D. showing they are a driver.

OVER NIGHT EQUIPMENT VEHICLE PARKING: At the DVC site only, if you wish to leave your equipment truck, overnight after the Saturday event, it must be moved to the overflow parking area across the street and then reentered with the busses upon your return. When arriving to park for the day at either site, all vehicles must arrive together in order to ensure that they can all be parked together. You may NOT send your equipment truck ahead of the bus arrival. **Repeat:** All vehicles must enter together.

WARM-UP AREAS: Are designated on the enclosed maps for both sites. Please do not deviate from this. Be sensitive to sound interference with bands already in competition. It's a bit of a walk for students at the 1/2/3A site so please allow ample time.

GATE TIME: Please be at the entrance gate no later than 13 minutes prior to your performance.

PERFORMERS RE-ENTRY ON SATURDAY: 1/2/3 A Performers and band Chaperones, who are wearing pit pass wrist bands are offered seating in the **lower tier of the stadium seating only.** Please remind your students to keep noise levels down when bands are on the field. **4/5A** bands will be seated in the back side bleachers due to limited space at DVC.

On Sunday, Non-Finalist Bands wearing their participant wristbands at FINALS are invited to attend finals free of charge. Show your wristband at the **performer gate**; move directly to the performer seats designated above on the back side bleacher area.

FOLLOWING YOUR PERFORMANCE: Please have your students **completely exit the performing area**. They are welcome to watch other bands **ONLY** from the appropriate assigned seating for non-performing band.

JOLISH PHOTOS: WBA will receive a fee from Jolish Photography, for every band whose group picture they take. PLEASE be supportive of this effort and take your students to this photo area after your prelim performance.

SOUVENIRS: WBA has expanded its product line of T-shirts, sweatshirts, and pins, etc. These items will be available for sale in the general Vendor Area at both sites. For the first time this year, they will also be available for purchase on-line following the event.

DVD Taping: Each band will receive a complimentary copy of their performance. You can pre-order at the site or order on-line after the event.
